Ride on the world's fastest and Southeast Asia's longest cable car to marvel at the stunning sunset and the 100-million-year-old forest.

Head to the Oriental Village and hop on a cable car to reach the island's second highest peak, Mount Mat Cincang. On the way, admire the stunning fauna, magnificent waterfalls and expansive rainforest as well as the breathtaking panorama.

Buy tax-free goodies at Jetty Point Shopping Complex, Saga Shopping Centre or Zone Shopping Paradise in Pantai Cenang. Then spend a day enjoying the splendid nature of

Langkawi. Discover Telaga Tujuh (Seven Wells) and see the waterfalls broken by seven natural pools where you might see the legendary fairies!

Langkawi is a diver's paradise. Visit Pulau Payar Marine Park surrounded by a wonderful coral reef with lush vegetation & marine flora. Enjoy the quiet and picturesque surroundings at Langkawi Golf Club, the first course built on the island, listen to the sound of tropical birds while playing in the rainforest at Datai Bay golf club.
